Letter of our President-Elect Adrian Goldin

Dear Members of ISL&SSL

At its last meeting in Seville, 21 st September 2011 our Executive Committed has elected me to be your next President from September 2012 until the closure of our XXI st World Congress, in 2015. This is a decision that honors me and for which I want to express my deepest appreciation I take the opportunity of this bulletin to address a first message expressing some of my ideas and projects.

The first one of all -my first commitment, without doubts -is to preserve the brilliant academic and institutional assets constructed by this Society since its foundation; it is a patrimony with which I feel strongly committed, that I am honored to serve, and to which I will provide all my activity and my efforts.

Especially and only by way of example, among many other purposes I intend to actively work with the organizing committees of our upcoming congresses, always with the shared purpose of comply with the aims of our institution. It seems important to me to promote the debates and exchanges inside them, rather than another reciprocally non-articulated presentations. The round tables, in turn should be organized in a way to promote and facilitate exchanges between the panelists, so they do not constitute a mere succession of reciprocally unrelated dissertations. I am also thinking about foreseeing the accomplishment of "poster sessions " that allow the presentation of researches which publication deemed relevant, even if not related to the topics considered in the congress in question ; it would be convenient if the admission of these proposals remains subject to the approval of rigorous reading committees , so as to ensure their scientific relevance.

The activities of the Society must attract the interest of both scholars and practitioners of the labor and social security law (and among them, the judges and the lawyers). Regarding scholars, in my opinion, it would suit to give value to the presentation of unofficial papers submitting them - when requested by the author- to an approval process by reading committees of significant level, so that would imply a recognition equivalent to the acceptance

of an article for publication in a prestigious journal, and a right of precedence for display them in the various activities of the congresses. The practitioners, in their time, should be encouraged to submit papers that contribute to the debates, and participate also in discussion forums leading up to each one of them, which could be enabled on the Society web-page and help to anticipate the concerns about the issues that have to be treated.

I also explore the idea of publishing an electronic yearbook together with the IALLJ as a way of deepening the relations of the Society with this entity so friendly and nearby to us, and thereby released the best of the scientific production published in the prestigious journals that integrate it. In addition, I will seek to encourage the formation of study groups and networks (beside linking the ISLSSL to those who are already integrated), to contribute as much as possible -in all that it is asked us and is to our scope - to its task, for example facilitating the contacts, promoting its products, proposing our congresses and our web -page both as a physical and a virtual place of meeting.

Naturally, the increasing development of our web -page will be a central aim of my management. In addition to its rich current content, I believe that this page must be a permanently updated instrument to show, besides other materials, the whole scientific production generated around the Society congresses, the discussion forums created and enabled inside them, as well as the spaces occupied by the researchers, and the study groups and networks that we manage to constitute around or near the Society. The web-page is today a communication instrument of the highest significance for an entity like that we integrate, so it is necessary to put the effort and resources that are necessary to contribute effectively to achieve the accomplishment of its goals.

This and other equally important aims - to promote the participation of young people and attending the formation of new national societies, -among many others that I prefer not expressing here to not overdo in the formulation of aspirations before having moved forward to concrete achievements - will summon all my efforts and my personal dedication throughout my management.

But let me make it clear that the most ambitious of my projects is my willingness to listen and learn from the ideas and proposals that all of you should want to reach to the society, as well as to receive the offers of participation in their effective accomplishment. The officers must fulfill the duties of their position. But this Society will be so much richer and dynamic - so much more compelling, more rigorous, more inclusive - the more committed all who we integrate it (as active and honorary officers, members of the Executive Committee and of national societies, institutional members of organizing committees and researchers) will be to its aims, projects and achievements. I would very humbly call all of you to take part in this endeavor.

I therefore remain at your disposal.

News from our Society

1. Decisions by the Executive Committee

Our Executive Committee met in Seville on 21 st September 2011 under the chairmanship of our President Professor Michal Sewerynski, assisted by me. The meeting was attended by representatives of 35 National Associations, several individual members and Honorary Presidents Blanpain, Sugeno and Servais. Below is a summary of the agenda discussed by the Executive Committee and the decisions it took thereabout:

1.- Membership of ISL&SSL: the Executive Committee approved the list of the national associations that were to be accepted as National Members of ISL&SSL on the base of the criteria set out in our by-laws approved in Sydney, 2009. The list, as approved by the Executive Committee is annexed at the end of this Bulletin.

2.- New Members of ISL&SSL: The Executive Committee welcomed the Indian Chapter of ISL&SSL, the Employment Law Association of Ireland and the Malaysian Labour Law Society as new members of ISL&SSL.

2.- Election of a President Elect 2012-2015: This process started at the beginning of this year with a call I sent to our national associations to nominate candidates for President of ISL&SSL. Further to this call I received the nominations of Professors Adrián Goldín (Argentina) and Oscar Hernández Alvarez (Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela), both submitted by their respective national associations. In accordance with our by-laws a vote by secret ballot was held during the Executive Committee meeting, the result of which was the following:

Total votes cast: 37
For Professor Goldin: 27 votes
For Professor Hernández Alvarez: 9 votes.

Professor Goldin was accordingly declared President Elect of our Society. He will take up as President on the closure of our XX World Congress, on 28 September 2012 in Santiago de Chile, and his mandate will run until the closure of the next World Congress in Cape Town, 2015.

CV of Professor Goldin is at the end of this Bulletin, as Annex I. I warmly congratulate him for his election and wish him a successful Presidency.

3.- Forthcoming Congresses of ISL&SSL:

IX American Regional Congress, The Executive Committee confirmed the venue of Guayaquil, Ecuador, in 2013. Arrangements concerning the actual dates, themes and working methodology will be worked out in the first half of 2012 so that a finalized proposal can be put before the Executive Committee meeting in Santiago de Chile.

XI European Congress, 2014: The Executive Committee welcomed the invitation by Professor Anthony Kerr, to hold this Congress in Dublin. A detailed proposal will be worked out during 2012, and will also be submitted to the Executive Committee for its formal approval in Santiago de Chile.

XXI st World Congress, 2015: The Executive Committee received invitations from our Brazilian Chapter, to hold this Congress in Sao Paulo, the Canadian Chapter, to hold it in Toronto and the South African Chapter, to hold it in Cape Town. It decided by a vote that the Congress will be held in Cape Town. I would like to bring to your attention that this will be the first time that ISL&SSL holds a world congress in Africa. I hope that it will benefit from massive participation, not only from Africa but also from the other regions in the world where we have national associations. Actual dates and agenda of this congress will be submitted to the next Executive Committee meeting in Santiago de Chile, September 2012.

4.- Financial report by the Treasurer

The Executive Committee took note of the interim financial report submitted by our Treasurer, Ms Corinne Vargha. It appreciated that generally speaking our finances are in good shape. Very few of our associations are in arrears of their dues, and our expenditures are kept under control. In keeping with our by-laws the tri-annual report will be submitted to the Executive Committee while at its meeting in Santiago, September 2012 together with the report by the Auditor, Professor Sten Evju.

5.- Report Servais

The Executive Committee started to consider the **Report on the working methods of our congresses and other proposals to improve our Society's outreach**, also known as Report *Servais* after the name of Honorary President Jean-Michel Servais, who had been requested by our Executive Committee in Sydney, Australia, 2009, to coordinate a working group to discuss this important question. Discussions on this theme will continue at the next Executive Committee meeting in Santiago de Chile, September 2012; it is expected that the Executive Commission will be ready to take decisions thereabout.

2. Tenth European Regional Congress, Seville, 2011

I warmly congratulate Professors Fernando Vald s dal R  and Jes s Cruz Villal n for the impressive success of this Congress, which was held from 21 st to 23 rd September 2011 at the Faculty of Law, University of Sevilla. It was followed by more than 500 participants

4. News from our members

Argentina

I have the deep regret to announce the death of Dr Geraldo von Potobsky in Buenos Aires. He was 85 years old. During many years Dr von Potobsky served with ILO as Chief of the Freedom of Association Service, where he did outstanding job. Later on he was appointed Chief of the Application of International Standards Branch, until he took an early retirement from ILO. He was doubtless a leading expert on international labour law, more especially on Freedom of Association issues. His very rich experience as a Senior ILO official is reflected in an impressive number of publications in the International Labour Review and in many other journals of Labour Law. He also co-authored **The International Standards System and Basic Human Rights**, (Westview Press, 1996), which for many years was perhaps the most important reference publication on the standard setting and application machinery of ILO.

I have asked Professor Franco to provide additional information on the full membership of this Society, its governing body and a record on its activities. In light of his reply I will make a recommendation to the Executive Committee.

Malaysia

I have received the following letter from our colleague Ram Thiagarajah, on behalf of our Malaysian Chapter:

Greetings! Hope all is well with you and arrangements for the 20th World Congress in Santiago 2012 are in progress. I am happy to inform you that the Malaysian Society for Labour and Social Security Law has been officially registered a fortnight ago and the Pro-term committee met yesterday to consider action plan for future activities. Dato Dr Cyrus Das, the President of the Society will communicate with you shortly regarding affiliation with ISL&SSL as a National Association in Malaysia. Labour Law Reforms to modernise Labour Legislation in consultation with the social parties under the Strategic Reforms Initiative programme of the Government for the New Economic Model are in progress since February this year. These tasks are likely to be completed by the end of 2012. Meanwhile, the National Wages Consultative Council Act has been enacted in September this year and a tripartite plus Council has been established. The Council is now deliberating on fixing Regional Minimum wages to be operational by end of this year. In another development an amendment bill to the Employment

Act deals with matters related to Sexual Harassment in work places. Further developments on these matters will be notified to you from time to time. Thanks & Regards, Ram
