

The Officers of the International Society for Labour and Social Security Law would like to express their deep condolences at the passing of Dr. Johannes Schregle, who was the Society's second Secretary-General, elected on the occasion of the Selva di Fasano Congress (Italy, 1974), and who served in this position between 1974 and 1988. At the time of his passing, he was one of the Society's Honorary Presidents.

Dr. Schregle was Head of the ILO Division for Industrial Relations and Labour Administration for many years and leaves a brilliant legacy as a jurist, as a high officer for the ILO, and particularly as the ISLSSL's Secretary-General.

One of Dr. Schregle's most important contributions was promoting a close relation between the Society and the ILO. He had an exceptional performance in the organization of the Society's World Congresses, such as the IX World Congress held in Munich (1978), the X World Congress held in Washington (1982), and the XI World Congress held in Caracas (1985).

Dr. Schregle's passing represents a great loss for the Society as well as Labour and Social Security Law in general. We would like to express our most sincere words of condolence to his family and the entire community of the ISLSSL.
